## Monthly Notes from Malahide Community Forum July 2015

- 1. Ciara Warren was welcomed to the role of Honorary Secretary.
- 2. **Financial Matters:** The Forum has made a donation to Tidy Towns to help in their excellent work.
- **3.** Planning/Development Issues: There are no new applications or decisions of relevance this month. Concern was expressed at the increase in illuminated signs in the village.

Forum is to contact FCC to request the latest position regarding works to Casino.

- **4. Transport:** It was agreed to make contact with Sergeant Cox to set up a meeting regarding various traffic issues.
  - FCC has recently changed the speed limit on the R124 from (mainly) 60kmph between Malahide and the Moyne Road to 50kmph. However there are inconsistencies with some signs showing 60kmph in one direction but 50kmph in the other. This has been brought to the attention of FCC.
  - FCC is commencing a Pilot Scheme for housing estates using 30kmph. The areas are: Seabury, The Warren, Grove Road and The Rise.
- **5. Environment:** FCC has dealt with the flooding at the end of Townyard Lane and it is believed this issue is now resolved. They have also fixed 3 leaks along The Mall.
- **6. Neighbourhood Watch:** There was no NW meeting last month. We would urge Residents' Associations to forward letters to T.D.s regarding the need for Malahide Garda Station to remain open.
