- Tax clearance certificate
- Bank account & appointed treasurer
- Illustrate ability to drawdown the funding
- Ability and show evidence of schedule to raise matching funds
- Illustrate long term sustainability

#### Summer Project Funding Programme 2016 - €60k awarded to 40 community groups

The Summer Project funding scheme provides financial support to groups that offer activity programmes for children during the Summer holiday period. Projects must have environmental, community and civic awareness elements and include intercultural or integration activities. The Community Division of the Council sees this funding programme as a way of supporting the community sector in the context of the overall work Fingal County Council does especially at a time when resources are becoming more hard-fought over. Last year a total of 37 groups, including 5 new groups, almost 3,500 children and young people availed of the Council's Summer Project Funding, and this year it is hoped that the number of participants increases.
